After lunch, enjoy a relaxing boat cruise on the Kazinga Channel, where you can continue your wildlife viewing. In the evening, set off for the ishasha sector of the park.

Early morning breakfast, there after set off for a game drive through the stunningly scenic park in search of the tree climbing lions of Ishasha. We shall head for lunch after this memorable experience. Kibale's most popular activity is the kanyanchu primate walk. 13 species can be sought and a good variety of diurnal monkeys invariably encountered but the stars of this twice daily show are chimpanzees. After this memorable encounter, we will enjoy lunch before heading out for an evening nature walk in Bigodi, a scenic area known for its rich habitats that attract a diverse array of bird and mammal species and return to our hotel for a nights rest.

Sempaya hot springs

Embark on your journey to the amazing Sempaya Hot Springs, where you can enjoy the breathtaking beauty of the Rwenzori Mountain ranges along the way. At the hot springs, you will discover the fascinating male and female springs, each with unique characteristics. The male spring is known for its impressive geyser-like eruptions, while the female spring features serene, steaming pools perfect for relaxation.

Basic Terms

Payment.

A deposit of 70% is due at the time of booking. The balance of 30% is due two weeks prior to departure.
